INFORMATION SHEET FOR NORTH CANTERBURY ROTARY ASHBY FAMILY YOUTH SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP

WHAT IS THE AIM OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS?

The aim of the Scholarships is to assist a local athlete to perform to their utmost ability. The Scholarship will provide an obtainable goal for the youth of the region to strive for and initiate a foundation that will breed a regional culture of sporting success and excellence.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Applications may be made by persons who [or whose parents or guardians] reside within North Canterbury (Waimakariri River to Conway River).

HOW IS THE SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTERED?

To access their scholarship funds recipients must provide copies of their receipts to the NCSRT for reimbursement. Receipts must be for relevant expenses – eg: travel to tournaments, accommodation at tournaments, training equipment, coaching expenses etc. Please note Scholarship is NOT paid out in a lump sum to finalists and winners. The Scholarship Administrator will contact the Scholarship recipient on a regular basis for progress reports.

HOW LONG IS IT FOR?

One year starting from the date of the Scholarship winner announcement, though there is some flexibility within this if key tournaments/expenses don't fall within that year.

WHAT ARE THE SELECTION CRITERIA?

In awarding a Scholarship, the following factors will be considered:

- Applicants must be between the ages of 12 and 20 as on the last day of the relevant consideration period.
- Applicants must have been selected by their regional organisation to represent the region within the relevant consideration period.
- Applicants must have an annual income of \$20,000 or less.

WHAT IS THE SELECTION PROCESS?

The successful Scholarship finalists will be chosen by an independent judging panel based on the information provided in this application form and from other sources, including media, who will also choose the Scholarship winner. The panel's decision is final.

WHO ADMINISTERS THE SCHOLARSHIP?

North Canterbury Sport & Recreation Trust to administer and control all matters related to this Scholarship.

REFERENCES

Applicants must include at least two references from people who can comment on their personal qualities and/or abilities.

CRIMINAL OFFENCE

Any prospective applicant who has been convicted of a criminal offence punishable with a prison term is not eligible for this Scholarship.

PRIVACY

The information contained in the application forms will only be used by the Trust for the purposes of determining successful candidates. Some information on the successful candidates will be required for promotion by North Canterbury Rotary and the North Canterbury Sport & Recreation Trust of the Scholarships in media releases and is a condition of acceptance of the Scholarship. Information may be released if requested under the Official Information Act.

The closing date for applications is **5pm on Friday 5th April 2024.**
